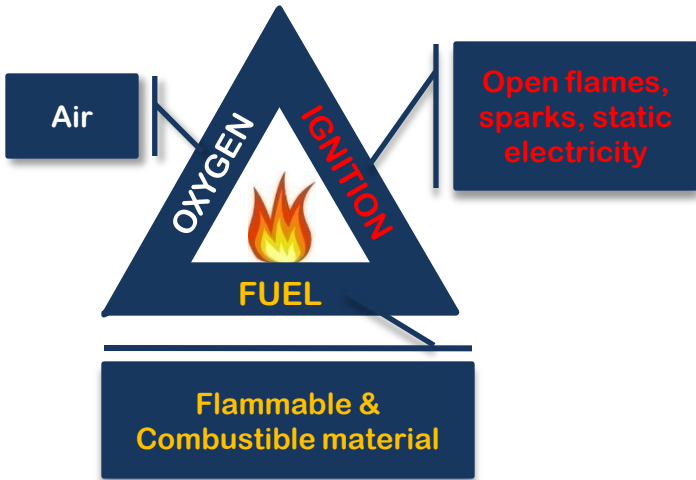


FIRE SAFETY

OSHA estimates each year approximately, 88 employees die due to fire and explosions.



Fire Safety

- Keep flammable materials such as gasoline & alcohol away.
- Keep combustible material such as cardboard, paper & wood away.
- Follow Hot Work Procedures prior to welding, cutting, brazing or other ignition sources.
- Know the location of the nearest fire extinguisher.
- Inspect fire extinguishers monthly.

Type of Fire Extinguishers



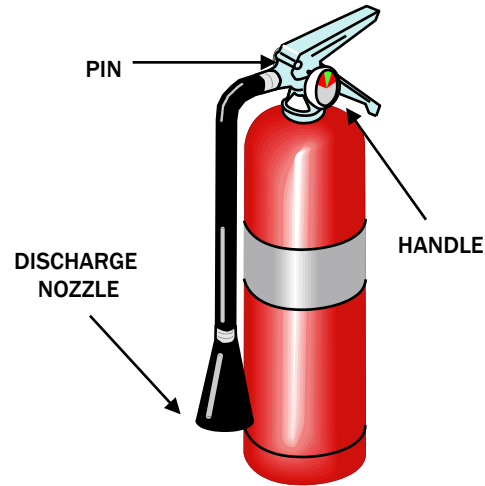
Combustible Material :
Paper, Cardboard, Wood, Plastic, etc.



Flammable Liquid :
Kerosene, Gasoline, Oil, etc.



Electrical Equipment:
Wiring, Circuit Breaker, Outlets, etc.
